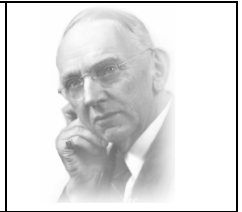

Family Karma (The Ties That Bind) by Kevin Todeschi

If after having read numerous books about reincarnation, karma, and grace you're still somewhat confused as to how these laws work in our lives, you might want to try this one. The author presents each of these topics in a clear and concise manner. karma is a debt with self." But the strongest element in determining a person's experiences remains free will.

Some situations mentioned in the book may be analogous to our own life challenges. We are thereby provided with a better understanding of how we got where we are, and can recognize that we are wholly responsible for our lives. Through use of our free will we can control our attitudes, intentions, and deeds -- and thereby our destinies. Personal karma is overcome by setting in place spiritual ideals with daily disciplines of prayer, meditation, and attunement to the divine within.

Grace is "living in conformity with divine spirit." Cayce described this pattern as "doing good, being kind, being patient, being forgiving, being loving in every experience of man's activity." The expectation is not that we accomplish this in one day, one week, or even in one lifetime, but rather that we grow in our awareness of our at-one-ment with creative forces little by little, step by step.

Why a particular relationship or life experience was drawn to us may not be essential, but rather how we react and respond. The "how" can be divided into two choices: to view and respond to the circumstances as stumbling blocks or as stepping stones and opportunities for greater development. Since we are creating our futures by how we live today, it makes ultimate good sense to choose the path of grace.



Spiritual Growth in Small Groups

The Cayce material insists that everything one needs lies within self, each becomes their own teacher and a teacher to others. Why work in groups? It magnifies the results. Group work offers: support to its members; clarification and feedback; motivation to persevere; a safe environment; other points of view; open discussion. Do You Have Your Astrology Report?

As a fund raiser for the Region, the Pacific Northwest Region offers personalized astrology reports for sale. These reports were created by professional astrologers via commercial astrology computer software. All reports are general astrology, with the exception of the Cayce Past Life report which uses interpretations from the Cayce readings, using both the Tropical and Sidereal zodiacs.

In general, Edgar Cayce recommended using the Sidereal zodiac (Persian calculations), as it is more accurate than Tropical (Egyptian calculations) by 30 degrees. Being students of the Cayce readings, we use the Sidereal zodiac for all reports unless the customer specifies Tropical. The reports are printed on high quality paper and bound in attractive comb binders with clear plastic front covers and heavy paper back covers. Sample astrology reports are on the Region website (<http://www.arepnw.org>). Click on the Astrology link.

Books and Remedies Report 2006

Book sales were good the past year; remedies sales, as always, were much lower. Books and remedies sales together totaled about \$11,000.00. Books (including CDs and DVDs) account for about 90% of the total. Mail order sales are a small portion of the total sales.

Two things account for good sales. First is offering a large variety of CDs and DVDs. Although books still sell quite well there is a great demand for audio and video media. Second, sales used to rely mostly on books based on the Edgar Cayce readings, but in the last year there was an increase in the amount of non-Cayce products.

Books and remedies were sold at the following events: a spiritual expo in Kennewick and the Fun Fair in Anacortes (the only non-A.R.E. events attended); Spring Seabeck, Summer Seabeck, the Portland retreat, and the Nancy Eubel program in Lynnwood (programs sponsored by the Region and area teams); and the Barbara Lane program in Richland and Kevin Todeschi program in Portland (sponsored by A.R.E. headquarters in Virginia Beach).

Castor Oil and Glyco-Thymoline are the only remedies from the readings that sell well; all other remedies are sold more as a service to program attendees than as income generating items.

Astrology reports are considered part of books and remedies. Thanks to David and Mary Kralman, the volunteers who take care of requests for astrology reports. All is going well.

Expenses include the cost of the products, the fee for the storage unit where the products are stored, booth fees at non-A.R.E. events, travel expenses (mileage, meals, and lodging), and shipping. A.R.E. members receive a 20% discount on A.R.E. Press books. The end result is about a 30% profit from the gross sales.

Thank you to all those who have been helpful in making the book and remedies sales so successful. Volunteers have helped with transporting products, staffing the sales tables, loading and unloading products, and much more. It is only with the generous support of volunteers that the Region is able to function.
