Maya: The Sequel Mu Rising and the Mayan Prophecies of 2012

Come hear the exciting sequel to last November's program on "The Spirit World of the Maya." Raymond Tarpey will present all new material, including the 2012 prophecies, at the May 17 discussion in a bigger, more comfortable meeting place.

You will also hear about Edgar Cayce's Testimony and the Mayan Records of Creation (Mayan Culture was formed at the crossroads between the ancient 'Lost Continents' of Mu/Lemuria and Atlantis), The Adam and Eves of Mu and Atlantis, and The Legacies of Mu and Atlantis in the American Lands.

The following is background material for Raymond's program:

When I began my study of the Maya during the 1980's, I had no idea that I was embarking on a quest for the powerful spiritual legacy and message of Mu/Lemuria. Up to that time, I had spent most of my life studying the languages and histories of ancient China and Japan. When I found that both the ancient Maya and the ancient Chinese saw a rabbit in the moon, I chalked it up as coincidence. But then these 'coincidences' began to pile up, including a fascination with jade as the symbol of the spirit/life force of creation and the sanction of dynastic rule; seeing bluegreen as a single color and having a glyph/character to represent it; and remarkable similarity in art and designs that show the ubiquitous dragon/serpent motif known in China as the 'tao-tiè,' a monster representing the fierce and awesome power of the spirit force within all things incarnate. In India, it is known as the 'kundalini' spirit power.

Finally, when I saw a Mayan glyph depicting Ixchel, the Mayan Moon Goddess with her rabbit companion (a direct parallel with the Chinese Moon Goddess 'Chang e' and her rabbit companion), I was not just astounded, I was absolutely mystified! How could this be? According to the mainstream view of ancient world history, there was no direct diffusion of Asian civilized cultures to the Americas. The native people of the Americas were considered to be solely the descendants of the Ice Age migrations of hunter-gatherer groups across the Bering Strait Landbridge between Asia and Alaska.



In my desperate search for an explanation of these ancient Chinese-Mayan parallels, I was led to the readings of Edgar Cayce. Cayce's testimony about the advanced civilizations of the 'lost continents' of Mu/Lemuria and Atlantis not only provided the answers to my questions, but added a new dimension to my studies. I now see all of my historical research as a quest for the ancient caches and inscriptions left by our ancient selves for our future selves in hopes of reminding us of our spiritual heritage and destiny. This quest is known as 'Spiritual Archaeology.'

Edgar Cayce reported that the Olmec and Mayan heartlands were strategically located between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans and were thus heavily influenced by various missions and migrations from Mu and Atlantis. When I re-read the ancient 'Creation Records' of the Maya, the Chinese and the Japanese, I was then able to see the ancient layers of influence from Mu and Atlantis. What especially surprised me was the power of the 'Spiritual Message of Mu.' It shines like a bluegreen gem within the ancient records, the Sacred Calendar and the 2012 Prophecies of the Maya.

During his recent presentation at Virginia Beach, Kevin Ryerson (the noted psychic who helped Shirley Maclaine) predicted that in 2012, "...an ancient civilization older than Atlantis will be discovered off Japan's coastal waters that will revolutionize the way we think of human history." Signs of these Mu ruins have already appeared off Yonaguni Island near Okinawa, Japan. My studies of Mu/Lemuria and the Mayan prophecies of 2012 have led me to the same conclusion. According to Edgar Cayce, the ancient souls of Mu are not as bound by karmic debt as the souls of Atlantis. I believe that the spirit influence of Mu is rising as part of the ancient divine plan of creation worked out for us by Amilius, our 'first and last Adam.' This spiritual message will change the way we look at the other spirit beings (plants, animals, rocks, water, soil, etc) coexisting with us here on Mother Earth. 'Mu Rising' will bring forth signs and invitations to all people to remember their sacred contracts and responsibilities for the preservation of all the life-forms which thrive upon the earth.

Raymond Tarpey is a trained historian whose areas of research are Mayan/Aztec, Anasazi, Japanese, and Chinese history and spirituality. This background, and information from Edgar Cayce's readings has led him also to do major work on the "lost continents" of ancient Atlantis & Mu/Lemuria.

Raymond holds an MA degree in Chinese History and Language (1973) from St. John's University. He is also an accomplished linguist, fluent in both Mandarin Chinese and Japanese, and is a student of Mayan languages and classical Aztec Nahuatl. Raymond has given presentations on Mayan/Aztec history in New York, Seattle, and Portland. He also gave a presentation on "The Legacy of Mu/Lemuria" at last year's A.R.E. Ancient Mysteries at Virginia Beach in October. Four of his articles have appeared in the A.R.E. Ancient Mysteries newsletter.

Steps Along the Path

Greetings! I've been as busy as ever and it's already time for another column. I've just finished the last paper for my "Mysticism and Mental Health" course through Atlantic University. I've been working for this moment for over a year and it brought a big smile of satisfaction. I can't remember how many books I've read but there were five just for the last paper, on the writings of two mystics in the 16th century, St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross.

Both lived in the church but faced many hardships from that very same institution. The Spanish Inquisition placed both under extreme scrutiny. However, all of their writings have a timely application for today as well. St. Teresa's *Interior Castle* has been a classic for centuries, but there recently has been a renewed interest in both of their writings. For example, medical intuitive and author Caroline Myss has centered much of her recent work on the writings of St. Teresa. St. Teresa's *The Book of My Life* is an autobiography written in her forties. St. John of the Cross's *Dark Night of the Soul* has become an expression for the inner turmoil one can face before illumination. One other aspect about this course on St Teresa and St John was that I took a trip to Portland to a book reading from Mirabai Starr, the translator of three of the books I used. It was pretty amazing to meet her after spending the last six months reading her translations. Mirabai flushed out their lives with insights that made the works easier to assimilate. There was a very personal moment for me at the reading. As Mirabai talked about her young daughter's death, it was apparent that she was still grieving from her loss, and that it was related to manic/depressive illness and to having a "spiritual emergency." These were exactly the same subject matters I'd spent the last year studying about. I thought I had come full circle. I told her about my own experiences and sent her the web address for the course I just finished.

What this all means for me is what lies ahead for next year, 2008. The first thing I'm going to do is register for another class "Introduction to Transformational Astrology," with the same Atlantic University teacher, Raye Mathis, who has a regular astrology column in the "Venture Inward" magazine. The course studies astrology "through the discoveries of depth psychology and the broader and more universal view of astrology that came through the Edgar Cayce readings." I've been interested in astrology for some time now and hope to find out the processes involved in this "arcane" science. If there is anyone interested in seeing the course outline and reading list, I will send it to you (gyumibe@gmail.com). I enjoy my studies through Atlantic University because they help me understand myself better.

Another upcoming ARE activity that I've already penciled into my calendar is Spring Seabeck with Kathy Callahan as the guest speaker. "Restoring Sanity to an Insane World" seems very apt for our present times.. We are indeed living in an "insane" time.

The only other date I've set aside is for another Virginia Beach conference in October with Gary Renard, author of "The Disappearance of the Universe" and "Your Immortal Reality." Both books resonated with me, particularly the lessons about forgiveness. I've started reading "A Course in Miracles," on which Reynard based his books, and have seen the benefits of following that Course. I feel that the ARE stands for an "all inclusiveness" when it comes to personal enlightenment. I also think that one's spirituality remains a highly individual matter. What works for one of us might not necessarily work for another.

For those within our NW community and abroad, I hope this New Year will meet everyone's idea of what an opportunity we have to be living in these challenging times. Let's all try reaching out to others. We all need this more than anything else. God bless.
